



Airline Ticketing Contract

Costa Rica Explorations, LLC, here and after referred to as “CRE” for the purpose of this contract includes employees, subcontractors, subsidiaries, affiliates, directors, founders, officers, successors, agents, and assigns. The individual purchasing this airline ticket for the participant’s travel to Costa Rica for _____ program will here and after be referred to as “purchaser” for the purpose of this agreement. If the purchaser is under 18 years of age, a legal parent/guardian of the purchaser will need to cosign this contract.

Purchaser agrees to the following terms and conditions set forth by CRE in the purchasing process of this airline ticket:

- The current total cost of this airline ticket deposit is \$_____ per participant for round-trip airfare to/from SJO Airport and is subject to change. This cost is an estimate only and includes the estimated price of the round-trip airline transfer, all applicable taxes and booking fees. This final cost is subject to current market conditions. CRE charges a \$50.00 per ticket booking fee. Luggage, meals and other fees are separate and the responsibility of the purchaser.
- The estimated deposit amount for this airline ticket is subject to change depending on the agreed upon final flight itinerary and airline ticket expense. If the original airline ticket deposit does change, this change will be reflected in the final deposit owed to CRE by the purchaser.
- Purchaser agrees to pay CRE for airline ticket deposit, which is included within the initial deposit of \$_____, by _____. Acceptable forms of payment are cashiers checks, money orders, or personal checks. Payment with credit card or on-line can be arranged upon request and is subject to applicable fees.
- Based on a mutual agreement of the flight itinerary and final airline ticket cost, the purchaser’s airline ticket expense total becomes non-refundable. In the case of cancellation by the purchaser, CRE will attempt to recover funds and/or notes of credit, but no return is guaranteed.
- The estimated deposit amount for this airline ticket is subject to change if the round-trip tickets, taxes, fees, or other costs change due to airline, government, other agency decisions or other uncontrollable conditions arise such as, but not limited to any form of natural disasters or economic conditions. CRE reserves the right to: (1) acquire any increase in costs from the participant due to increased fares or other circumstances (2) refund a portion of the airline ticket should a less expensive airline ticket arise before tickets are purchased by CRE.
- The purchaser must complete the “Airline Passenger Information” page and submit it with the full payment in order to fully process the airline ticket.
- The purchaser agrees to all terms and conditions as set forth by the designated airline company for international travel.
